The stairs to the water will be fixed. Siltation fence will be put up. The cat tails will be taken care of. The volleyball net will be replaced. The Chairman asked her about lifeguards. She mentioned that she has hired three. She will keep a close eye on her budget. Barney also said that swimming lessons might be offered.
